F.I.R., we find that 3. Having perused the general and omnibus allegations are made by the complainant-respondent no.2 against the relatives of the husband's family, namely, the father-inlaw, mother-in-law and the three sisters-in-law (appellant nos.2 to 6). No specific date, time or manner of incident has been mentioned in the F.I.R.

It is already well settled by this Court in the case of 'Geeta Mehrotra & Anr. vs. State of U.P. and Anr.' reported in (2012) 10 SCC 741 and also in the case of 'Kahkashan Kausar @ Sonam & Ors. vs. State of Bihar & Ors.' in Criminal Appeal No.195 of 2022 decided on 08.02.2022, that such vague, general and omnibus allegations against the family members/relatives implicating them in matrimonial disputes are an abuse of process of law.

5. Accordingly, we allow this appeal and quash the F.I.R. No.537 dated 26.06.2022, registered at Police Station Sir J.J. Marg, Greater Mumbai *qua* the present appellant nos.2 to 6 only. As against the rest of the accused, the proceedings will continue in accordance to law.
